As the ARISA CHILD project comes to a close, we want to extend our heartfelt thanks to all our partners, stakeholders, and participants who contributed to its success. Over the past thirty months, the project has laid important foundations for strengthening child-friendly justice and supporting professionals working with children in conflict with the law across Europe.

Key achievements at a glance

🔍 Training programme for working with sentenced children: new opportunities for professional development in Bulgaria

- ✅ Comprehensive Training Needs Analysis in 10 countries, identifying gaps and challenges in working with juvenile justice-involved children.
- ✅ Policy Recommendations tailored to national and EU-level decision-makers, promoting evidence-based reform.
- ✅ Two Study Visits to Italy & Portugal with over 20 participants, fostering cross-country learning and exchange.
- ✅ Development of an Innovative E-learning Course, available in 6 languages, offering over 8 hours of training for juvenile justice professionals.
- ✅ Almost 200 professionals across the EU enrolled to the course.
- ✅ Stakeholder Engagement Events in 5 countries, reaching over 200 professionals and policymakers.
- ✅ Multidisciplinary dialogue through panels, workshops, and roundtables involving justice, education, social work, and civil society sectors.

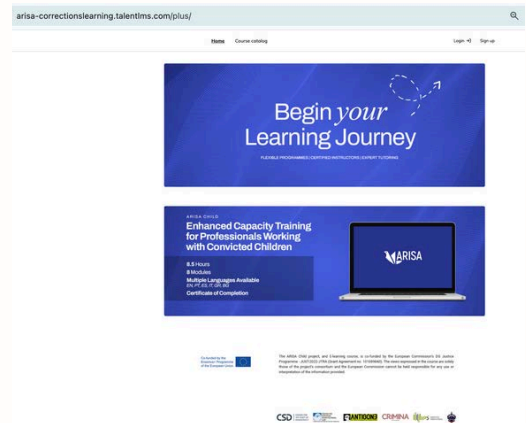
